Girls Community Commitment



Narrative:

Implementation of action research projects on child marriage.

Main outcome: Exploration of facilitators and barriers to the realization of the right to sexual and reproductive health of adolescents and youth and evaluation of innovations to improve access to services for adolescents and youth in the provinces of tanganyika, kinshasa, kwilu, Haut-katanga, and south and north kivu and Kasai-Occidental in the democratic republic of Congo by 2030.

Our interdisciplinary center for community health development (CIDCS), which is in the midst of planning in partnership with the interdisciplinary center for international health development at Sherbook University and the ABC center for academic expertise in mental health at Sherbook University, constitutes a baseline for our commitment. 140,000 beneficiaries are targeted as part of our commitment by 2030 at a rate of 17,500 per year, 20,000 per province.

Outcomes:

60% of adolescents and youth in 7 provinces have access to SRHR services by 2030. The rate of child marriage is reduced to 55% in the Democratic Republic of Congo by 2030.
