The following text summarizes the commitment made by the government of Sweden at the London Summit on Family Planning on July 11, 2012.

POLICY & POLITICAL COMMITMENTS

Sweden's priority is to work in the most effective way for the rights and improved health of women and girls in the most vulnerable countries in Africa. The Swedish government will continue to be a major player, both financially and politically, in the issue of family planning. Sweden also commits to ensuring that support of family planning utilizes existing structures for financing and support, and is contributing to the broader agenda of MDGs 4 and 5.

FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS

Sweden will increase spending on contraceptives from its 2010 level of US \$32 million per year to \$40 million per year, totaling an additional \$40 million between 2011 and 2015. The government plans to increase its contribution to MDG 4 and 5 from its current amount of \$450 million per year.
