

Amref Health Africa Commitment



Narrative:

Amref Health Africa commits to:

- Support health systems strengthening for provision of quality comprehensive sexual and reproductive health services as an integral and essential component of universal health coverage
- Support advocacy initiatives to ensure political commitment and adequate resource commitment to family planning programmes
- Support the review of effectiveness of existing accountability models eg Motion Tracker, Track 20, PMA, development and capacity strengthening of accountability frameworks and monitoring the translation of these commitments to action. Amref will support the implementation and scale up of existing accountability model e.g Motion Tracker framework, convening stakeholders and capacity strengthening of accountability frameworks and monitoring the translation of these commitments to action.
- Additionally, we have already set up a framework for social accountability in collaboration with UNFPA for the ICPD+25 commitments (<https://www.yactmovement.org/caravan/>), most of which include commitments on SRH/FP for adolescents and youth, hence leveraging the existing platforms also to support young people to lead social accountability for FP/SRH indicators in their countries.
- Provide technical advisory support to countries, CSOs, FP2030 country focal points, youth organisations and advocates.
- Support the development of FP 2030 integration strategy of into other development and health agenda to increase the participation of women and youth in FP advocacy, elimination of stringent policies, social norms and practices that limit access of adolescent girls and boys to age-appropriate family planning services and information.
- Amref will support efforts that enable young people to have access to age- and culturally appropriate information about contraceptive options through schools and other relevant channels, including community and faith-based organisations.
- Partner with High Impact Practices team to provide support in advocacy, social accountability, CSOs engagement and FH/RH policy design and implementation
- Support reporting and dissemination of FP trends and HIPs briefs in countries, regionally and globally through digital and social media channels among others
- Collaborate with technical experts, FP2030 regional hubs and country level partners to host dissemination of HIPs, learning and adaptations

Outcomes:

1. Influence at least 2 adolescent and youth SRH related policies in each of the 7 countries where Amref has offices, which will contribute to resource allocation for adolescent and youth health services.
2. provide a digital platform for youth-led social accountability on SRH/FP commitments with the below outcome:

- a. Youth-led organizations in at least 15 countries in Africa track SRH/FP commitments for ICPD+25, to ensure policy-implementation and resource allocation for inclusive and universal access to SRHR and ending harmful practices that affect adolescents and youth.
