Marie Stopes International (MSI) Reproductive Choices Commitment



Narrative

1. Commitment 1 Links to FP2030's Success Statement: A woman or adolescent girl's decision to use modern contraception is supported and accepted.

Globally in 2020 our teams served 12.8 million people - 35,000 every day - with high-quality sexual and reproductive health services. By 2030 we plan to serve at least 120 million women and girls with high quality SRH services (clients not users). Under our Pillar 1 'Leave no one behind' strategy, we will aim that 80% of these clients will be from the poorest and most marginalized communities, and that 50% of our clients will be under 24 years old and 20% of our clients will be under 20 years old (an increase from 15 to 20% in the proportion of our clients who are under 20).

We will partner with governments to establish public sector partnership models to transition towards national ownership. We commit that 50% of MSI supported service delivery sites will evolve towards national ownership by 2030.

2. Commitment 2 Links to FP2030's Success Statement: Political commitment and policy environment are expanded and consistently supportive

In every country where we work access to rights-based contraception services is restricted by unnecessary clinical, legal or policy barriers. We commit to ensuring that in 30 countries where we work women and girls will have improved access by MSI actively influencing laws, policies and the enabling environment, and holding duty bearers to account for the commitments they have made.

3. Commitment 3 Links to FP2030's Success Statement: Health systems meet the information, service, and supply needs of individuals.

Of the 56 million abortions that take place each year worldwide, an estimated 25 million are unsafe. Many of these abortions result from a lack of access to rights-based information and services contraception. We will support the elimination of unsafe abortion by ensuring 1 in 3 women across MSI partnership who have an abortion will access it from a safe MSI or MSI-supported product or service (by delivering 7 million safe abortion / post-abortion care services by 2025), whilst enabling others to provide safer services ensuring that every woman or girls is only 'one contact' away from quality safe providers.

Outcomes

By 2030 we plan to serve at least 120 million women and girls with high quality SRHR services. We commit that 50% of MSI supported service delivery sites will evolve towards national ownership by 2030.
