Civil society plays a critical role in evidence-based advocacy for driving progress on Family Planning and ensuring that the related commitments are realized. However, CSOs can only be able to hold the governments/ commitment makers accountable if they systematically and consistently track the contributions, efforts and progress made by their governments. Lessons from FP2020 demonstrated that civil society engagement in advocacy and accountability for FP was successful in achieving increased community support and engagement, high quality service delivery to the most vulnerable and program accountability to the different communities served.

Samasha commits to continue implementing a multi-stakeholder accountability framework holding FP and MCH government commitment makers accountable by December 2030.

Outcomes & Values

- A vibrant movement and partnership in place among governments, civil society and development partners delivering on their FP and MCH commitments using mutual accountability principles.
- Mutual accountability for commitments are realized and sustained.
