LAO PDR'S FAMILY PLANNING VISION FOR 2030: Accelerate progress towards the achievement of universal access to sexual and reproductive health and reproductive rights.





1. Improve access to adolescent and youth-responsive health systems for contraceptive use

To lower the maternal mortality ratio and adolescent pregnancy rate, and address unmet need for family planning (FP) among unmarried adolescent girls, the government will:



Enforce family registration and family laws



Focus on partnership with community engagement, the Mass Organization/CSOs/NGOs and the private sector, and other intersecting sectors

Expand comprehensive sexual education within lower and high level education



Enhance innovation and digital technology to increase access to contraceptive information and uptake



2. Ensure the availability of quality and safe YFS/FP information and services

To decrease the unmet need for FP among adolescents and young people (15-24 yrs) from 31.1% to 12% by 2030 the government will:



3. Increase the availability (no stock out) of Contraceptive /RH commodities

To reduce the "no stock-out" status of five modern contraceptive methods at lower health facility levels, the government will:



Increase demand for quality FP information and services



Improve availability of quality postpartum and postabortion FP services



Build the capacity for health staff

FINANCIAL COMMITMENT OBJECTIVE: INCREASE FAMILY PLANNING FUND TO SUPPORT THE AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE AND COMMODITIES AT THE LOWER LEVEL

To diversify sources of funding, the government of Lao PDR will increase domestic resources to finance family planning commodities by at least 5% annually from the current annual allocation of 120 million LAK, and ensure full disbursement of these funds.

They will also:

- Generate evidence for FP contribution to measure and improve maternal health outcomes
- Engage members of parliament and other sectors
- Enhance CSOs' advocacy efforts
- · Strengthen the use of data for decision-making
- · Mobilize the private sector in contributing to FP financing
- Include family planning in public and private health insurance packages
- · Strength the expenditure reporting and tracking

Approach to Accountability

Lao PDR will utilize:

- National FP platforms such as DHIS2, surveys, and census
- Quarterly progress update meetings convened by CSO and youth focal points
- · Overall review meetings led by the MOH every six months
- Channel based platforms where stakeholders will share regular updates and progress

The government of Lao PDR will use a mutual accountability approach to monitor progress of commitment implementation. They will provide opportunities for dialogue and cooperation between various government actors, civil society, and other key stakeholders to implement, review and monitor the progress of the FP2030 country commitments.




COMMITMENT PRINCIPLES:
