Narrative:

The National Strategy for the prevention of adolescent pregnancy since 2015 is aimed at the prevention and care of unintended pregnancies, in addition to addressing sexual violence in girls, in a comprehensive manner with differentiated actors, bringing them closer to the health and welfare system through a series of opportunities that promote the development of their life project in a diverse manner within a framework of their rights.

We will continue to promote this project in a comprehensive manner with differentiated actors, bringing them closer to the health and welfare system through a series of opportunities that promote the development of their life project in a diverse manner within a framework of their rights. In this sense, we will continue to promote this strategy from an inter-institutional accompaniment (mentoring) ensuring actions that allow the Comprehensive Sexuality Education to become a reality and that will allow us to reach 2022 with at least 10 workshops on youth perspective, human rights and sexual and reproductive rights for 300 public servants; 30 training processes (workshops, capacity building training) for at least 1000 adolescents and young people that allow them to equip themselves with tools and skills for the full exercise of their sexuality, recognizing themselves as subjects of rights but also as political subjects. Finally, promote 1 campaign for the attendance of adolescents and young people to friendly health services.

Political Advocacy: We have followed Mexico's progress in the 2030 Agenda and related to the voluntary report, towards Beijing+25 and El Foro Generación Igualdad we made an alliance with other youth organizations in the country to conduct webinars and actions for dissemination and monitoring of this agenda, we are part of the coordinating group of the CSW 66 and contribute to the coordination of regional civil society spaces towards the CSW 65 and participate very closely to the ENAPEA (National Strategy for the Prevention of Adolescent Pregnancy).

Research: We continue to feed our research on early unions and data for advocacy in the prevention of teenage pregnancy.

Training: We conducted training processes for adolescents, youth, public officials who work directly with adolescents and mothers, fathers and people who are responsible for the care of adolescents and youth. We have taken these processes online through webinars and workshops.

Communication: This year we strengthened our process of social decriminalization of abortion with the monitoring of our microsite abortaresmiderecho.org, and the documentary on abortion. We also prepare digital content for our social networks on an ongoing basis that allows the approach to information such as teen-friendly services, abortion, violence or sexuality from pleasure.

Outcomes:
