Fundación Oriéntame Commitment



Narrative:

Orientame is committed to work in Colombia, in raising awareness and direct provision of sexual and reproductive health services, with a gender and rights approach. Specifically, we provide abortion and post-abortion care, including the initiation of post-abortion contraceptive methods, as well as counselling and initiation of interval contraceptive methods.

Our commitment contributes to advance Goal 5 of the Sustainable Development Goals: Achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls. Specifically, the 5.6 target Ensure universal access to sexual and reproductive health and reproductive rights, in accordance with the Program of Action of the International Conference on Population and Development, the Beijing Platform for Action, and the Montevideo Consensus.

Currently, in Colombia, Fundación Oriéntame raises awareness on sexual and reproductive rights among 7,000 adolescents, young people and adult women annually. By 2025, in line with the EWEC strategy, we aim to reach 10,000 adolescents, young people and adult women annually, sensitized to decide freely on the use of contraceptive methods and on the decision to have or not to have children. So far, in 2021, Orientame has provided counselling and uptake of modern contraceptive methods to 4,344 women between 10 and 24 years of age. By 2025, we expect to provide contraceptive care to more than 4,700 adolescent and young women in different regions of the country.

Outcomes:

- In the next four-year period (2022-2025), at least 28,000 young and/or migrant women will have access to clear and timely information on contraceptive options within the framework of sexual and reproductive rights through a communication and awareness strategy implemented by Oriéntame in 7 cities in the country.
- In the next four-year period (2022-2025), the initiation of modern contraception methods, in young women and adolescents (under 25 years of age), will have increased at least by 5%
